- The students will review all Arabic letters taught to date.
- The students will learn the following letters: و, -4, و
- The students will learn vocabulary utilizing the letters taught.
- The students will read the letters with the long and short vowel sounds.
- The students will write the letters with the long and short vowel sounds.
- The students will understand how to form the letters at the beginning, middle and end of the words.

Curriculum Corner:



LANGUAGE ARTS:

- The students will read and write words with 'r' control. (ar, er, ir, or and ur)
- Understand that "ed" word endings indicate that the word is in the past tense. The students will apply "ed" word endings into their writing.
- The students read high frequency with fluency.
- The students will read with increasing fluency, enhanced comprehension and greater accuracy.
- The students will incorporate learned comprehension strategies into their daily reading, enhancing their understanding of various texts.
- The students will explore and write rhyming poetry.
- The students will include sensory language terms to enhance ideas in creative writing.



MATH:

- The students will continue to work on the measurement and 2D and 3D units.
- The students will relate length to the understanding of size.
- The students will recognize the height, width, or depth of an object as lengths in various orientations.
- The students will compare and order objects according to length.
- The students will interpret shape in two and three dimensions.
- The students will compose and decompose two or three dimensional composite shapes
 - The students will find symmetry of two dimensional shapes.

SCIENCE:

- The students will understand the attributes of the living Earth and space by investigating natural systems and their interactions.
- The students will investigate the needs of plants and animals,
- The students will observe and describe similarities and differences between plants and animals.
- The students will explore how plants and animals require environments that allow them to meet their needs.



SOCIAL STUDIES:

- The students will explore some of the major physical features of our world.
- The students will identify place names of landmarks in Alberta including natural landmarks with First Nations, Metis and Iniut names.
