Some children have trouble expressing themselves verbally using concise and organized words; if you noticed that your child needs help in that area, here are simple strategies that you can follow to help:-

***Be Patient,** Do not get frustrated when your child cannot answer your questions quickly and clearly, give them the time they need to organize their thoughts.*

*· **Provide Speaking opportunities,** enroll your child in after school activities that will give them the opportunity to practice their communication skills, such as Quran and public speaking clubs.*

*· **Use cutouts from comic books or newspapers,** cut out the panels from a comic book or newspaper comics, mix them up and ask your child to reorganize them in the right order, sequencing pictures and a dialogue is effective practice for organizing thoughts.*

*· **Be your child's audience,** for school projects that entail presentation, encourage your child to present at home in front of a mirror, then in front of you. Always applaud your child for their efforts.*

Remember that some children are late bloomers, with your continued support and guidance they can reach their potential.


