CURRICULUM FOCUS

Grade 9s will be beginning their fourth and final unit of Math 9, Statistics and Probability. This week, students will be learning the following concepts from Chapter 11:

- Factors that affect data collection: bias, use of language, ethics, cost, time and timing, privacy, cultural sensitivity.
- Collecting data: population vs. sample
- Probability in society: predictions vs. assumptions
- Differentiating between theoretical probability vs. experimental probability.

ISLAM AWARDS

Fifth Annual ISLAM Awards, for Grades 7–12: Friday, June 22, 2018

Addendum: In order to qualify for an Islam Award, students must receive a grade of 50% or higher in all subjects (core and non-core) in addition to meeting the requirements for each award.

QURANIC MEMORIZATION & RECITATION AWARD

- ❖ Awarded per grade to the top three students: for memorization, recitation, and tajweed.

ISLAMIC STUDIES AWARD

- ❖ Awarded per grade to the top three students in Junior High and top three in High School.

ARABIC LANGUAGE AWARD

- ❖ Awarded per grade to the top three students in Junior High and top two in High School.

ACADEMIC AWARD

- ❖ Awarded in three achievement categories to all qualifying students in each grade.
 - *Honourable Mention:* requires a 75% or higher combined average in four core subjects
 - *Honours:* requires a 80% or higher combined average in four core subjects
 - *Honours with Distinction:* requires a 90% or higher combined average in four core subjects
- ❖ Achievement benchmark is based on a student's year-average up to May 24, 2018.

DIPLOMA & AP STARS ACADEMIC AWARD

- ❖ Awarded to students scoring 80% or higher in the Diploma Exam (first attempt, not retake), and/or 4/5 or higher in an AP Test.

TOP ACADEMIC AWARD

- ❖ Awarded to the student with the highest overall average in each grade.

LEADERSHIP AWARD

- ❖ Awarded to three students in both the Junior and Senior High age group.

ATHLETICS AWARD

- ❖ Awarded to the most athletic boy and girl in both the Junior and Senior High.

EIA PROFILE AWARD

- ❖ Awarded to one student in grade 12 (see student handbook p. 4–5).

ALUMNI AWARD

- ❖ Awarded to one EIA Alumni who has the most volunteer hours.
